BOARDING INFORMATION AND CHECK LIST

Vaccinations: If your pet is not currently a patient of All about PetCare, please ask your current veterinarian to fax their medical records to 513-424-4664. If your pet is not current on his/her vaccinations, we would be happy to provide the necessary vaccines or services during their stay. If you have questions regarding the cost for vaccinations, please give us a call.

Dogs must be current on the following vaccinations - DHPP, Rabies, Bordetella (within the last six months). Both cats and dogs must have had a fecal examination within the last six months due to the risk of parasite transmission to other boarders as well as the hospitality staff.

Cats must be current on the following vaccinations - FVRCP and Rabies. Both cats and dogs must have had a fecal examination within the last six months due to the risk of parasite transmission to other boarders as well as the hospitality staff.

Food & Treats: We have Science Diet Maintenance food available to both our canine and feline guests and often spoil them with treats. Please let us know any specific feeding instructions or dietary restrictions. We do, however, encourage you to bring your pet's food with you, along with any special treats, in an effort to diminish the risk of gastrointestinal issues due to diet change. Please bring only the amount of food necessary for the duration of the visit (some clients use Ziploc storage bags for each feeding). You may want to give yourself a cushion of a few extra meals in case your travel plans change.

Bedding: We provide comfortable cots and bedding in our Traditional Runs and toddler beds and blankets in our Luxury Suites, as long as your dog does not chew these items (we do not want your dog to ingest inappropriate items!). Our feline guests receive a comfy cat bed to enjoy. Our hospitality staff provides housekeeping services throughout the day to ensure your pet's comfort.

You may bring your pet's bed or items from home if you wish. Please be sure the items are marked with your name on it. Please be aware that some pets act differently while they are boarded and may chew their items. While we will do our best to ensure items are returned in similar condition, please be aware that we cannot be responsible for any personal items left.

Toys: You may bring any toys that you feel will make your pet's stay more enjoyable. We have a wide range of outdoor toys that our staff will play with your pet during his/her playtime. If your pet has a favorite game- fetch, ball, Frisbee, etc- please let us know! *Please note: we will not and do not offer our guests any rawhide chews due to the risk of choking.* If your dog is a chewer, please consider bringing Nylabones, Kongs, etc that not as likely to be choking hazards.

Medications: As a full-service Veterinary Hospital in addition to a boarding facility, we have skilled veterinary staff to medicate your pet as needed during his or her stay. We request that you bring your pet's medications with the labeling intact with specific instructions to ensure accuracy in your pet's medical routine. Insulin injections can also be given. There is a nominal daily fee for medication administration if the medication was not prescribed by our hospital.

Health Changes or Special Notes: Please notify us of any significant or chronic health concerns your pet may have. Your pet's health is our first priority at All about PetCare and any pertinent information is always helpful and appreciated.

Emergency Contacts: Please have two emergency contacts prepared for check-in. While we always prefer to speak with you, the owner, we realize that you may need to leave the name of another family or friend to be a contact should you be unable to reach.
